TERMS OF REFERENCE

Local consultant for conducting Macroeconomic Report for policy discussion/dialogue

1. Background of the Project

The Australia-Viet Nam Economic Reform (Aus4Reform) Program works with the Vietnamese Government to boost productivity and competitiveness in Vietnam. The program supports the development of quality policies, laws, and institutions through advocacy, consultation, and by strengthening the evidence base for economic policies drawing on international experience and expertise, especially from Australia

Specific outcomes that the Program will contribute to by the end of 2020 include:

- a. An improved and more equitable business enabling environment resulting in the formal registration of at least one million private enterprises by 2020.
- b. More competitive and transparent product and factor markets
- c. Stronger competition law institutions, including an amended competition law, and restructured competition agency and enforcement mechanisms.
- d. Improved evidence bases on impact of efforts to accelerate rural restructuring
- e. Increased evidence base and awareness of the links between Women's Economic Empowerment (WEE).

The Program will help the Government of Vietnam achieve its goals through the following four target components:

- Building more Competitive and Transparent Markets and Business Enabling Environment
- Ensuring Markets Operate Competitively in Consumer and National Economic Interests
- Facilitating the Restructuring of the Rural Economy
- Greater Business and Women's Voice in Investment Climate and Economic Restructuring Issues

And a Flexible Fund to support reform initiatives to Respond to Emerging Bottlenecks to Productivity Growth and Innovation.

2. Objectives of the activity

The activity aims at:

- Consolidating the most updated assessments of regional and global economic prospects affecting Viet Nam's economy

- Providing independent, scientific evaluation of macroeconomic developments on a periodical basis and macroeconomic outlook for the next quarter and/or subsequent year;
- Supporting the strengthening of analytical capacity and efficiency and consultation on macroeconomic policies in the short and medium term, thereby serving the execution of the Government, the Ministry of Planning and Investment and other related agencies.

3. Scope and Approach

Local consultants will carry out the following tasks:

<u>Senior consultant 1</u>: 01 macroeconomic report

- Developing outline for independent macroeconomic report.
- The report is about 30-35 pages A4 (including tables and appendices) with focus on following issues:
 - Regional and global economic situation affecting Vietnam's economy during its implementation (especially economic growth, trade and investment).
 - Macroeconomic policy adjustments (monetary, fiscal, trade and investment policies) in the quarters and related key issues and issues (*Reviewing legal documents directly relevant to the management of macro policy instruments, with focus on some of the most concerned documents*)
 - Analysis of macroeconomic developments in the quarters, focusing on economic growth; import and export; investment; price; monetary market movements; exchange rate; state budget; employment; (*each sector needs to have relevant quantitative analysis based on the appropriate model, associated with early warning of pressures and issues that may appear during the proposed time and subsequent stages*).
 - Quantitative analysis of pressure on foreign market;
 - Recommendations on orientations and measures for macroeconomic execution and policies.
- Presenting his/her study at the dissemination workshop.
- Consulting with CIEM and relevant agencies and experts to adjust and clarify analysis in the Report (*if necessary*)
- Participating in the editing of final report on macroeconomics.
- Providing requirements for Sectoral/junior consultants for his/her support.
- Working with Senior Consultant 2 to prepare discussion paper for the policy dialogue.

<u>Senior consultant 2</u>: 01 report on outstanding economic issues

- Developing outline for outstanding economic issues during the proposed times
- The report is about 30 pages A4 (including tables and appendices) with focus on following issues:
 - Consultation with CIEM to select and conduct in-depth analysis of one (or some) outstanding macroeconomic issues.
 - Analysing of the current situation of selected macroeconomic issue(s), identifying of causes and forecasts in the near future
 - Proposing recommendation and orientations for the coming period.
- Presenting his/her study at the dissemination workshop.
- Consulting with CIEM and relevant agencies and experts to adjust and clarify analysis in the Report (*if necessary*)
- Participating in the editing of final report on macroeconomics.
- Providing requirements for Sectoral/Junior consultants for his/her support.
- Working with Senior Consultant 1 to prepare discussion paper for the policy dialogue.

<u>National consultant 3&4:</u> Synthesizing documents/data and providing sectoral/industrial analysis, and supporting 2 senior consultants

- Developing outline for sectoral/industries analysis in collaboration with senior consultants and CIEM
- The report is about 30 pages A4 (including tables and appendices) with focus on following issues:
 - Collect official, updated data of following economic indicators: GDP growth of the whole economy and by sectors (agriculture-forestry-fishery; industry-construction; services), by economic ownership (state sector; domestic private sector and FDI sector; Growth rate of consumer price index and price index of commodity groups; Growth rate of export price index and import price index; Interbank exchange rate, commercial bank exchange rate, and market rate; The balance of payments and component balances; Credit growth; Interest rate movements; State revenue, expenditure and deficit and component items; Export and import growth in general, and import and export to some major markets; Investment; Developments of industrial production; Employment; and other indicators as required by 02 senior consultants.
 - Collecting available information on regional and world economic situation affecting Viet Nam's.
 - Consolidating legal documents issued during the proposed period that directly affect the administration of macro policy instruments.

- Consultation with CIEM and senior consultants to conduct in-depth analysis of selected industries/sectors.
- Providing opportunity and challenges for the selected sectors/industries and forecasts in the near future
- Proposing recommendation and orientations for the coming period.
- Presenting his/her study at the dissemination workshop.
- Consulting with CIEM and relevant agencies and experts to adjust and clarify analysis in the Report (*if necessary*)
- Participating in the editing of final report on macroeconomics.
- Conducting some other analytical works specified by 02 senior consultants.

- <u>Workshop</u>: The consultant will present the research results at the dissemination workshop organized by the Program.

- <u>Discussion paper</u>: within 2 weeks after the policy dialogue.
- All reports are submitted to Office of the Program via email (in pdf and word form).
